Stan presented a fascinating talk and demonstrated how to improve fifteen member paintings. He emphasized "loving the whole thing" and not overworking the point of interest while not thinking through the rest of the piece. He stated authoritative communication of intention with a decided style, connectedness, balance and originality are important. Accurate drawing, values, composition, mood and universal subject are all more important than color and technique. Stan encouraged painters to,

"Move away from recipes."
