

POLICY: Signature Status 5 January 2023

Receiving Signature status in the Spokane Watercolor Society is a significant event and should be treated as such. The Bylaws specify the requirements for attaining signature status. In recognition of achieving signature status the Board President/Membership Chairperson will send a letter of acknowledgement to the new signature member. A signed certificate with the official seal of SWS imprinted on it will also be sent to the new signature member. Signature nametags are presented at the annual business meeting when appropriate during the recognition portion of the meeting for new signature members. Individuals who receive signature status may use the letters SWS behind their name as soon as they receive their signed certificate from SWS.

Electronic communication will not be used as the only form of transmission of either of the two documents referenced above. Each year at the business meeting the new signature members for SWS will be recognized before the membership.
